



Marymount Primary School Achievement Awards

Marymount Primary School is blessed with so many exceptional and persistent learners. At Marymount we have various opportunities to recognise our students. The following awards can be obtained at Marymount Primary School throughout the year, Academic Excellence, Learning Growth and Mary Amongst Us Awards.

<u>Academic Excellence Award Criteria:</u> Are awarded to students who are succeeding well above the Achievement Standard. This is categorised by receiving at least (7) "A" levels of achievement in classroom and specialist-based subjects, one of which <u>must</u>include English and/or Mathematics.

<u>Process:</u> (Semester 2 only) Students from Years 3-6 will be chosen from 'Student Report Data.' Leadership Team will review this data and teachers will provide work samples to the Leadership Team, if deemed necessary. Review of this data also includes consideration of effort results and work habits within these subject areas.

<u>Award:</u> Certificate of Attainment and Marymount Academic Medal

Specialist teachers (Years 3-6 only) will also be asked to nominate students (between 1-3 per year level) in Semester Two who have achieved 'well above' the achievement standard in their curriculum area.

Award: Certificate of Attainment

<u>Learning Growth Award Criteria:</u> At Marymount, we believe every student can progress in their learning journey. The Learning Growth Award is for a student in each class (P-6) who has demonstrated outstanding growth in a particular curriculum area, significant improvement in learning data from the term and/or work habits.

<u>Process:</u> Each term, class teachers will moderate work samples (in any key learning area) to nominate a student from their class. A nomination form will be completed noting the outstanding learning growth (see attachment). Support staff to consider nominations include the Primary Learning Leaders and the Assistant Principals.

Award: Certificate of Attainment and a 'Learning Growth' badge of recognition.

"Mary Amongst Us" Award Criteria: As members of the Marymount School community we:

- * Make a difference
- Act responsibly and safely
- * Respect Everyone
- Say Yes to Faith and learning

Mary Amongst Us Awards are nominated by teachers for students (P-6) who 'walk with Mary every day' when they:

- Say 'Yes' and accept challenges; like Mary of the Annunciation in Luke 1: 26-38 and Mary of Bethlehem in Luke and Matthew
- **Pray**, reflect and praise God; like Mary of the Magnificat in Luke 1: 46-55
- **Show love** for our family; like Mary of the Visitation and at the Temple in Luke 1: 41-42, 44 and Luke 2:41-58

- Are **thoughtful and considerate** of others; like Mary of Cana in John 2:1-12 and Mary of Calvary in John 19:25-27
- Are a Marymount School community builder; like Mary of Pentecost in Acts 1:1

Process: APRE to invite teachers each semester for 1 nomination.

Award: Certificate of Attainment and a 'Mary Amongst Us' Academic Medal.

End of Year Awards and Year 6 specialised:

- Spirit of Mary Award positive behaviour, high standards and a strong learning ethic.
- Charlie Clark All Rounder friendly, mischievous, fun loving and positive interactions with others.
- Pat Dolan Award Genuine friendship and concern for others.
- St Vincent de Paul Inspiration Award Helping hand to those in need.
- Simon Hogan Memorial Music Award- Excellence in 'The Arts'.
- Sportsperson of the Year Award (across the school)
- Sports Encouragement Award (across the school)
