Staff Changes for Semester Two

This year will see a number of changes. The Beach-a-thon will begin at Miami Surf Club (cnr Hythe St and Marine Parade) and continue north along the beach.

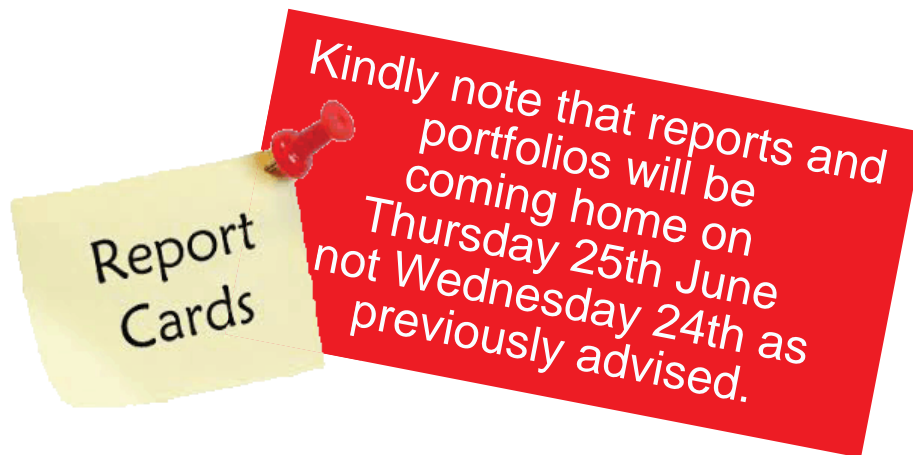
